About the reserve

This chain of flooded clay pits and extensive reed beds along the Humber bank west of Barton-upon-Humber is a legacy of the brick and tile industry. The site comprises open water, large areas of reed bed, grassland, hedgerow and scrub.

The Visitor Centre has wonderful panoramic views across the reserve and the estuary, along with a gift shop and refreshments.

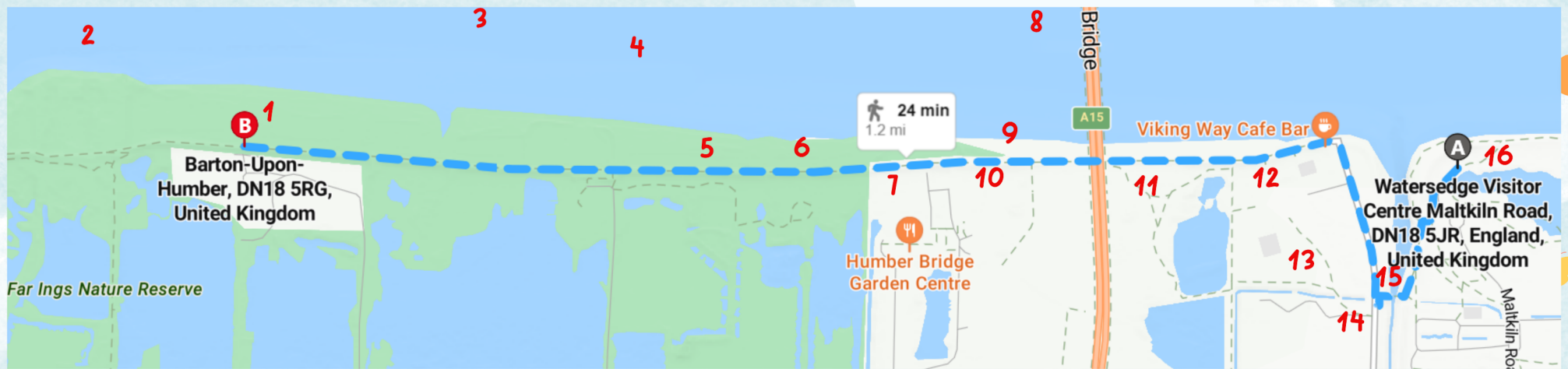
The route is about a mile long and will take about half an hour in one direction at a gentle walking pace.
