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BARROW UPON HUMBER WALK

2.75 miles

START

At the church at the end of High Street, Barrow upon Humber. DN19 7AA

Barrow can be reached via the A1077 from Barton or via the B1206 from the A15.

THE WALK

1. Leave the church in a southerly direction along the High Street passing the market place on your left.
2. Turn right into Barton Lane following the high footpath/pavement rising steadily to a junction.
3. Turn right into Ferry Road following the pavement on the right.
4. At a Y junction cross Ferry Road East and take the road signed to Barrow Haven following the path to the right of the road. Near the Beck Bridge the path disappears, continue carefully past Castle House.
5. Turn right into West Hann Lane.
6. Turn right at a finger post along a headland path with a hedge on your right. Cross the footbridge over the Beck following the footpath in the same direction.
7. Turn left at the end of the footpath into Cherry Lane.
8. Turn first right into North Street and cross a road junction with the John Harrison School on the corner on your right. Continue along North Street towards the church.
9. Cross the road and follow a short footpath to the right of the church which brings you back to your starting point.

TERRAIN

Pavement is followed from point 1 almost to point 5, between points 2 and 3 it is uphill on a high pavement. From 3 to 5 there is a steady slight descent. West Hann Lane is flat and quiet. From point 6 a field headland path descends slightly to the Beck and rises slightly to Cherry Lane. Pavement is followed slightly uphill back to the church.

TIME

Between 1hr and 1½hrs at a leisurely pace.
