

OWSTON FERRY: BURNHAM ROAD



3 MILES

→ **START** Church Street, near St Martin's Church, Owston Ferry. Careful parking here please.

📍 THE WALK

- 1... Follow the road (towards East Lound) to the right of the church.
 - 2... Turn right along Church Walk.
 - 3... At the end of Church Walk, turn left into a lane (Burnham Road). Follow the lane steadily uphill, over the hilltop to the end of the surfaced road, where a private farm track drops down to the right.
 - 4... Retrace your steps, but continue straight on past Church Walk and the school to the road junction.
 - 5... Turn right into Epworth Road.
 - 6... Cross the road to take the first road on the left (Gashouse Lane).
 - 7... At the end of Gashouse Lane, turn right along Bagsby Road and continue to the road junction.
 - 8... Turn right and continue up High Street which merges into Church Street back to the start.
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🗺️ **TERRAIN** This is basically a 'there and back' walk up a surfaced lane along a ridge, terminating at the end of the surfaced section. The highest point is 37 metres above sea level. However, the views are extensive – the gradients are gradual, nowhere steep. Remaining roads are fairly quiet and road crossings straightforward.

🕒 **TIME** Allow 1½ hours or more to enjoy the views.
