Items	Notes	Suggestions for higher quality This is not assessed
Kitchen		
Matching crockery and cutlery	Sufficient for number of guests unit sleeps. Extra if dishwasher in unit. Plenty of teaspoons essential, nothing chipped or cracked. Egg cups should be included.	Greater range of items e.g. cups and saucers and different sizes of plates and bowls. A good quality range of crockery is suggested. Guests looking for very high quality may expect small knives and forks and soup spoons.
Glassware	At least tumblers and wine glasses.	A water jug.
Serving dishes	To suit target market – possibly salad bowl, platter, fruit bowl, etc. Consider small containers / dishes for serving crisps and nuts.	Greater range and quality.

Teapot, milk jug and container for sugar		Cafetiere or coffee maker might be included, depending on target market.
Bread knife, carving knife and other sharp knives	Larger capacity units need a greater range, so that if a group is cooking together, they have sufficient numbers.	
Chopping board(s) & bread board		
Range of kitchen utensils	Tin opener, potato peeler, grater, potato masher, ladle, kitchen scissors, wooden spoon, whisk etc.,	For very high quality lettings more gadgets would be expected. For example an electric whisk, pestle and mortar, food processor.
Kitchen bowls and measuring jug	Kitchen scales should be considered, depending on target market.	For very high quality lettings, guests may expect bakery items such as cake tins, cooling racks, rolling pin, cutters, pie dishes, casserole dish etc.

Range of saucepans (including one non-stick) and at least one frying pan		
Colander or sieve	If the unit takes large groups, consider adequate provision of large saucepans and frying pans.	An omelette pan might be appreciated. Ensure frying pan is in very good condition.
Oven glove or mitts		
Electric Kettle and Toaster	A toast rack might be considered.

Basic supply of cleaning materials, washing up liquid	Guests might appreciate a starter supply of dishwasher powder/tablets.	Kitchen roll, foil, cling film etc. might be considered.

Table cloth/placemats, as appropriate		Linen/cloth napkins might be appreciated by some guests.

Facilities to dry clothes	Airer or clothes line with pegs.	A laundry basket might be appreciated.
Vacuum/broom, floor mop and bucket, dustpan and brush	As appropriate and dependent on housekeeping services offered.
